Qualifications

The Université du Québec en Outaouais is a French-speaking university

The Département des sciences naturelles at Université du Québec en Outaouais, Québec (Canada), invites applications for a tenure-track position in natural sciences (ecological biochemistry). The applicant holds a PhD degree in environmental sciences, biochemistry, analytical chemistry, molecular biology or in a related discipline. Postdoctoral experience and research accomplishments related to the temperate biome will be considered advantageously. The candidate must demonstrate the ability to rapidly and independently obtain external research funding. It is essential that the successful applicant can contribute to teaching at all levels, particularly at the undergraduate level (e.g. biochemistry, molecular biology, biotechnology, analytical methods).

Applicants must have a good working knowledge of written and spoken French at the time of the interview.

Description

The successful applicant, depending on her or his expertise and motivation, may develop a research program in one or more fields in which biochemistry is relevant to address ecological issues, for example and without limitation: biochemical interactions in aquatic or terrestrial ecosystems, metabolomics applied to ecology and the environment, chemical ecology, aquatic or terrestrial biogeochemistry, phytoremediation, ecotoxicology, etc. The candidate must also show an interest and an ability to collaborate with the other professors at the Département des sciences naturelles and with researchers at the Institute of Temperate Forest Sciences (ISFORT) (isfort.uqo.ca).

ISFORT, an applied research organization located in Ripon (Québec), is dedicated to the multidisciplinary study of the temperate deciduous forest. The successful candidate will contribute to the promotion and visibility of the Institute, the Department and the University.

Applicants are requested to include a cover letter with their application, a copy of their PhD diploma, a curriculum vitae including a list of publications and the name of three references, reprints of recent peer-reviewed articles, a statement of research interests, a statement of teaching interests and philosophy, and any document establishing teaching experience.
